

Amendment Five to the Bylaws of
Opequon Creek Project Team
Adopted April 1, 2009

Article III –Membership, Voting, and Fee

Section 1. :Members. There are two classes of membership: Regular Members and Associate Members.

- a. Regular Members:** Regular Members shall be volunteer citizens residing in, or owning land in, or doing business in, or individuals having an interest in, the watershed. They shall have voting privileges as described in Section 2 of this Article.
- b. Associate Members:** Associate Members, such as government agency employees and volunteers participating in OCPT-sponsored events, shall be non-voting members of this organization. They shall have the same standing as Regular Members with the exception that they are not allowed to vote and are not required to pay a Membership Fee.

Section 2: Voting. All Regular Members of the organization shall have one vote provided they have attended or participated in a minimum of three meetings and/or activities within the last year.

Section 3: Membership Fee. A membership fee is to be established at the last meeting of each year and shall be due in the first quarter of the following year from each Regular Member.
