Directions to Van Metre Stonebridge:

I-81 Exit 13, East on King Street 1.5 miles, Left onto Queen Street .1 miles, Right onto East Burke Street (CR-36) 2.5 miles, Right into parking lot just before the bridge. **OR**, from Route 45 (Shepherdstown Road) ~5 miles from Shepherdstown, turn south on Blairton Road 1.4 miles, Right on Golf Course Road, cross the bridge and turn left into the parking lot.

Items to bring with you that day:

- Your boat, kayak or canoe. Let us know if you need one (we have extras).
- Bug spray and sunscreen.
- Water and snacks.
- Your own personal floatation device (PFD).
- Wear sturdy shoes and be sure your eye glasses are secure to your head.
