**Location:** Wheeler property off Berkeley Station Road, north of Martinsburg, WV.

**Directions to Wheeler property:**

*From Interstate 81...*

- Take Route 9E exit 16 and travel towards Martinsburg. Turn left onto Route 11 North.
- Stay on Route 11 to the first traffic light which should be Berkeley Station Road. (There is a 7-11 here)
- Turn right on Berkeley Station Road and go 3/10 mile to Shape Charge Road.
- Turn right and proceed to the end of Shape Charge Road. The Wheeler's driveway is a continuation of the road. Here the road turns to gravel and it is 8/10 mile to the residence.
